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


#### **Utah Unemployment Claims**

March 16, 2020 – April 26, 2020




#### **Utah Weekly Unemployment Claims**

### **Utah Economic Forecast**

- Peak job loss reached April 2020 will be the apex for the economic fallout. Modest job
  growth will likely resume in the next 60-90 days, but there will be an employment drag until
  treatment/vaccine.
- **Gradual reactivation** Plan on a longer stabilization phase than the urgency phase, which lasted about seven weeks. Think dial, not switch.
- Unequal impacts Reactivation will vary by industry and geography.
- **Plan for unevenness** Since this is not a short-term problem, but a new risk we manage, plan for additional economic disruptions, though not as severe.
- **Recovery phase** Recovery depends on our adaptations, innovations, iterations, and medical science. Reassess strategies regularly as you follow a two-year plan.
